1. What are the differences between Custom, Box, and RTA Cabinets?

- Custom Cabinets: Offer the highest level of personalization and quality. They are tailored to your specifications but are more expensive and time-consuming to produce.
- Box Cabinets: Strike a balance between cost and customization. They are quicker to obtain but offer limited flexibility in design.
- RTA (Ready-to-Assemble) Cabinets: The most cost-effective and readily available option, but they require assembly and offer minimal customization.

2. Does H & H supply cabinet hardware?

We will supply hardware for all projects. You can still select your preferred hardware; however, we will handle the sourcing and supply. It is important to have the hardware available for our installers, as this helps us proactively address any potential challenges that certain hardware may present during production.

3. What is the difference between custom and brand-name cabinets?

- Custom Cabinets: Tailored designs specific to your space, high flexibility, superior quality and craftsmanship, but generally more expensive and time-consuming to produce.
- Manufactured Cabinets: Pre-designed and produced in bulk, offering affordability, quick availability, and consistent quality, but with limited customization options.

4. Do I need an appointment to visit the showroom?

6. Can my cabinets be any color or stain of my choice?

Yes, we can offer nearly any paint or stain color available.

7. Do you offer cabinets with glass doors?

We provide a range of exclusive glass options to compliment the overall design of your cabinetry.

8. Can I keep my existing cabinets and just get new doors?

Yes, we can reface your cabinetry by replacing doors and drawer fronts, often providing a cost-effective solution to refresh your space.

9. Can you match my existing cabinets' design and color?

We can color match any paint sample you provide and will make every effort to match stain colors, though an exact match may not always be possible due to variations in wood aging and species.

10. Who is responsible for removing my old cabinets?

The customer or their contractor is responsible for removing existing cabinetry. H & H does not provide demolition services.

11. What are standard cabinet sizes?

Base cabinets and vanity cabinets are typically 34 ½" high. Base cabinets are 24" deep, while vanities are 21" deep. Wall cabinets are set at 54" above the finished floor, with heights depending on ceiling height. Custom cabinetry can be designed to any desired dimensions.

12. What is the turnaround time on new cabinets?

Prefabricated cabinets are readily available, typically requiring 3 days to a week for delivery. Custom cabinetry, built to order, usually takes 10 weeks to produce, depending on the complexity of the project.

13. Will I get to see a layout of what my cabinets will look like?

Absolutely! H & H will collaborate closely with you during the design phase, providing floor plan drawings, 2D elevations, and 3D renderings to help you visualize your project before final approval.
